Along with the inter district competition the association will hold seminars and training courses for curators ,coaches, trainers, physio, umpires ,match referees and scorers. Fitness and training camps have also been ear marked for various age groups after the inter-district competitions. The U-14 selected players will be trained at PCA cricket academy where they will start the training from 15th May and four camps will be held for them of 10 days each.

The season will kick start with U-16 tournament for ML Markan Trophy from 17th April to 10th May 2018. All the matches will be of three days duration while the final will be of four day duration. The tournament will be played between Chandigarh, Ropar, Amritsar and Mohali in Pool 1 and Patiala, Bathinda, Jalandhar and Ludhiana in pool 2.

Dhruv Pandove Trophy for U-19 will be played from 22nd May to 10th June. The matches will be of 2 days duration and the participating teams are Chandigarh Gurdaspur, Amritsar and Ludhiana in Pool 1 while Pool 2 will consist of Patiala, Kapurthala, Jalandhar and Mohali and the one day U-19 for DP Azad trophy will be held from 1st September to 9th September 2018 between Chandigarh, Amritsar, Ludhiana, Patiala Jalandhar and Mohali at Patiala and Ropar.

The senor inter district tournament for Katoch Shield will be held from 19th May to 3rd June 2018. The matches will be of two day duration. Pools 1 consist of Chandigarh, Gurdaspur, Amritsar and Jalandhar while Pool2 will have Patiala, Bathinda, Ludhiana and Mohali.

The under-23 inter district tournament will be played from 13th June to 1st July 2018. All the matches will be of two days duration while the final will be of four days. Poll 1 will consist of Chandigarh, Gurdaspur, Amritsar and Ludhiana while pool 2 will have Patiala, Ferozpur, Jalandhar and Mohali.
