Punjab –A defeated HPCA –A by 5 wickets in a 50 overs match played at I.S. Bindra Stadium PCA Mohali. Winning the toss and opting to bat first Himachal lost their first three wickets for 18 runs in 3.1 overs. Thereafter Ankit Kalsi 33 off 43 balls with 5 boundaries and Nakul Raj put on 69 runs for the 4th wicket before Ankit Kalsi was caught by wicket keeper Gitansh Khera off Manender Singh. Nakul Raj was joined by Shubham Negi and the duo put on 83 runs for the 5th wicket before Shubam Negi was run out by Rajwinder Gollu for 28 for 52 balls inclusive of one boundary. Nakul Raj was the next to go when he was caught by Manender off left arm spinner Varun Khanna for 83 off 109 balls with 8 boundaries.
