

**SUPER OVER SEALS CHANDIGARH'S FATE IN PUNJAB STATE INTER DISTRICT T-20  
TOURNAMENT PLAYED AT GMSSS Sector - 26 Chandigarh.**

In a high scoring T-20 match between Chandigarh and Jalandhar at GMSSS Sector 26 which went into the Super over Jalandhar pipped Chandigarh by 1 run to garner 4 points while Chandigarh got zero. Chandigarh skipper Manan Vohra won the toss and opted to bat. He opened with Sarul Kanwar and the duo put on 20 runs for the first wicket before Sarul Kanwar was caught in the deep by Abhishek off Pargat for 07. Thereafter Manan Vohra and Jaskaran Singh added 41 runs for the 2<sup>nd</sup> wicket before Manan Vohra while going for the 2<sup>nd</sup> run was caught short of his crease by Rahul for 35 off 34 balls with 5 boundaries. Thereafter Jaskaran Singh and Gaurav Puri put on 55 runs for the 3<sup>rd</sup> wicket before Jaskaran was caught by Mansab Gill off Rishab Bhagat for 35 off 31 balls inclusive of 2 boundaries and 2 sixes. Gaurav Puri who was in an irregistrable mood smashed six huge sixes in his blistering knock of 46 runs off just 19 balls before being caught by Manpreet off Pargat. Thereafter Gaurav Puri unbeaten 36 off 13 balls with 3 boundaries and 3 sixes and Bhagmender unbeaten 20 off 9 balls with 2 boundaries and one six added 56 runs for the unfinished 5<sup>th</sup> wicket in just 3.1 overs. Chandigarh scored 188 for 4 in the allotted 20 overs. For Jalandhar Pargat Singh 2 for 40 and Rishab Bhagat 1 for 46 were the most successful bowlers.

Replying Jalandhar opened with Mansab Gill and Pargat Singh and the duo put on 54 runs in 4.5 overs before Pargat Singh was caught by Gaurav puri off Gaurav Gambhir for 40 off 19 balls studded with 5 boundaries and 2 sixes. Mansab Gill went on to hammer a hard hitting 76 off 51 balls studded with 6 boundaries and 3 sixes. Jalandhar were 155 for 4 in 18.2 overs from where Himanshu Satyawar and Abhishek Gupta added 33 runs for the unfinished 5<sup>th</sup> wicket in the space of 10 balls taking Jalandhar's score to at par of 188 for 4 in 20 overs. Himanshu Satyawar remained unbeaten on 29 off 14 balls with one boundary and 3 sixes while Abhishek Gupta remained unbeaten on 09 off 4 balls with one six. For Chandigarh Gaurav Gambhir 2 for 41 and Bhagmender 1 for 41 were the main wicket takers.

The match having being tied the super over was bowled and Jalandhar scored 22 runs with Abhishek Gupta 11 off 3 balls and Himanshu Satyawar 11 off 3 balls. Arpit Singh conceded 22 runs for Chandigarh. Jaskaran 1 off 1 balls and Gaurav Puri 20 off 5 balls could muster 21 runs in the over bowled by Rishab Bhagat thus losing to Jalandhar by 1 run.
