

PCA EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING HELD

The Executive Committee meeting of Punjab Cricket Association was held today at 11.30 am at Dhruv Pandove Conference Hall, I.S. Bindra Stadium, PCA Mohali. The meeting was Chaired by Chairman Mr. I.S. Bindra. The chairman welcomed the two new Vice Presidents Mr. Rajinder Gupta of Trident Group from Barnala and Mr. Chaman Lal Malhotra former Punjab Captain and former Chairman of Punjab Senior Selection Committee from Ludhiana. Thereafter Mr. M.P. Pandove, Honorary Secretary General took up the agenda for the meeting and had the minutes of Executive Committee Meeting of 24th January, 2016 confirmed along with the ratifications of the gist of decisions of the Administrative Committee Meetings from January to May, 2016. Thereafter, the progress of work relating to construction of PCA's New Stadium at Mullanpur were explained by the Project Director Mr. B.K. Bassi.

The executive committee also approved the proposal of Solar Energy Power in the existing system through PEDDA. The income and expenditure statement of ICC T-20 matches successfully staged by PCA was approved. The PCA also revised the subsidies and payments being made to the affiliated district cricket associations for cricketing activities and development of the game. The executive committee also granted associate membership to Fazilka District Cricket Association.

The Honorary Secretary General informed the House that the New Vice President Mr. Rajinder Gupta had assured that a proper cricketing facility will be built in the premises of Trident Industries at Barnala with proper seating arrangements. PCA would like to have its women cricket activities at that centre. It was also proposed to buy land at Ludhiana for building up a proper stadium for which Mr. Rajinder Gupta would also help.

The committee noted the changes made in the state championships on the recommendations of Tournament and District Secretaries Committee. Now all districts will play all age groups from next year.

Mr. M.P. Pandove Honorary Secretary General advised the secretaries of the District Cricket Associations to be very particular on maintenance of books accounts of their district for audit and income tax purposes. Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
