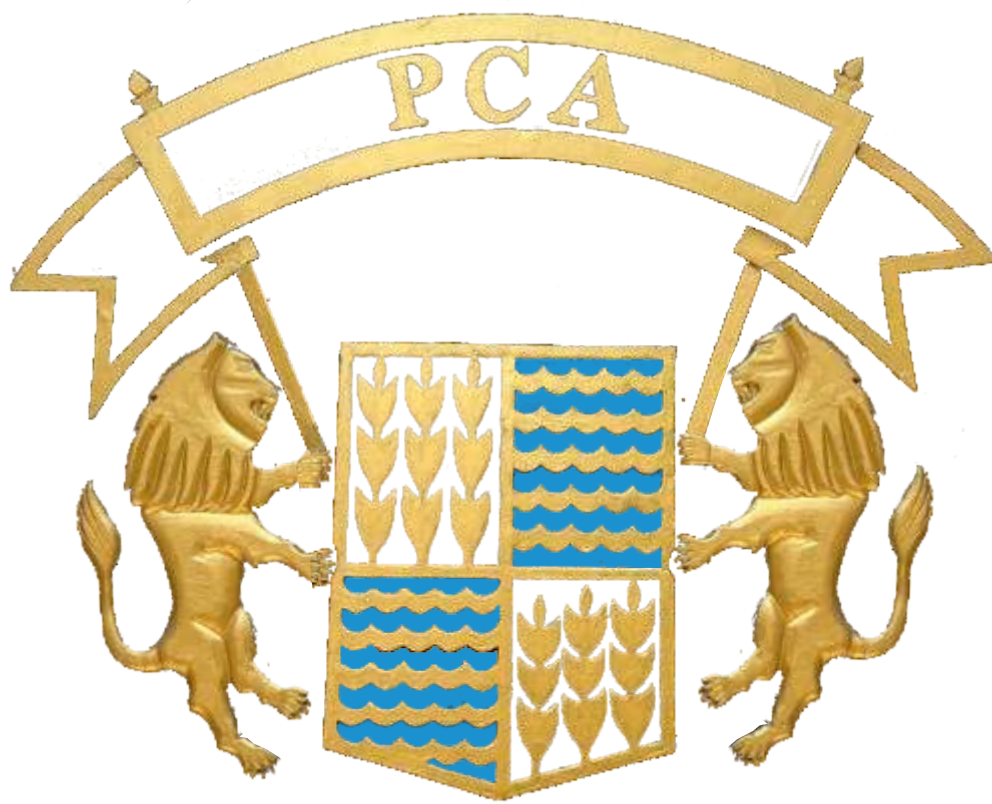

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING DATED 30TH OCTOBER, 2021

The Annual General Body Meeting of the Punjab Cricket Association (PCA) was held today i.e. on 30th October, 2021 at 11:30 a.m. at Pool Side Lawn, I.S. Bindra Stadium, PCA, Sector-63, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali.

Sh. Rajinder Gupta, President of the Association was in Chair.

Leave of Absence: -

Sh. Rajinder Gupta, President, PCA welcomed all the members to the meeting. He further informed the House that Sh. I.S. Bindra, Senior Member and Former President is on his way and will be joining in some time.

Sh. M.P. Pandove then moved a resolution which was duly seconded by Sh. Viswajeet Khanna as under: -

“Whereas Rule 15 (3a) provides that the Secretary, PCA is obliged to maintain, keep and record the minutes of the AGM and the relevant rules read as under:

“Keep and maintain the minutes of Annual General Body Meetings and Special General Meetings of the General Body, the meetings of the Apex Council and of the Committees appointed by the General Body in appropriate books and shall cause them to be properly and correctly recorded and confirmed.”

However, since the Secretary, PCA is not a “Category A” member; he cannot participate in the AGM and in the last AGM dated 28.03.2021 also he did not participate in the process and thus, could not record minutes, though he was allowed to attend the meeting. His functions were discharged by CEO.

Application submitted by the Secretary to the Hon'ble Ombudsman seeking permission to discharge functions as Secretary and discharge duties in terms of Rule 15 and 16 in the AGM scheduled today has been disposed of just giving him permission to be present in the meeting. In the last AGM also, he was just present in the meeting and this mode has not been objected to this time as well. There is no order on his plea in terms of Rule 15 and Rule 16, thus, the same has not been accepted by way of necessary implications.

AGM cannot be adjourned as quorum is complete and important decisions are to be taken for smooth



functioning of the Association.

In order to work out a solution within legal framework, the President is requested by the General Body to exercise his powers under Rule 15 (1) (c) and take appropriate decision as regards recording of minutes of the minutes and correction, if required.

“The President shall also exercise such functions and duties as he may be empowered with by the General Body or the Apex Council.”

The General House unanimously approved the resolution and authorized the President, who was chairing the meeting, to take appropriate decision in this regard.

The President then proposed that Sh. Deepak Sharma, CEO can be assigned this responsibility and he be requested to record the minutes and carry out corrections, if required and after approval, the minutes be kept and maintained as per law. The President further pointed out that while dealing with the similar situation in the last AGM dated 28.03.2021, Sh. Deepak Sharma, CEO had been given this responsibility and we should stick to the same practice in the present AGM also. The House had unanimously authorized Sh. Deepak Sharma for recording of the minutes and there was no objection from any corner. Therefore, in the present AGM also we should follow the same practice to ensure consistency in the functioning and more-so for the reason that there are no grounds for deviation from the past practice.

The House agreed to the proposal of the President and Sh. Deepak Sharma, CEO has been unanimously authorized for recording and correction of minutes of the AGM scheduled for today that is; 30.10.2021.

Item No.1: To confirm the Minutes of the Annual General Body Meeting dated 28th March, 2021. (Already circulated-Annexure- 'A')

And

Item No.2: Action Taken Report with complete RAM (Responsibility Accountability Matrix) and timelines. (Annexure- 'B')

The President informed the members that the Action Taken Report pertaining to the decisions of the last Annual General Body Meeting dated 28th March, 2021 may be discussed along with the confirmation of the Minutes. The House agreed with the President.

- a) The President conveyed his thanks to the Membership Committee constituted in the last Annual General Body Meeting for recommending the members to grant the Life Membership in most amicable way. He then requested Sh. M.P. Pandove to brief the House.

Sh. M.P. Pandove requested Sh. Viswajeet Khanna, one of the Members of the Membership Committee to brief the House.

Sh. Viswajeet Khanna informed the members that Government officials and public servants, persons holding public posts can be enrolled as Life Members but they cannot office bearers in PCA but there is no bar or prohibition in the Rules and Regulations to enroll them as life members of PCA. This is in consonance with the Justice Lodha Committee report, accepted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. It has been discussed that Justice Lodha Committee report was accepted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the year 2016 and on the said date and even thereafter some of the life members being the then sitting Hon'ble Judge and some of the Government officials remained as life members of PCA. He further informed that all the concerned Government Officers are well versed with the Lodha Committee Guidelines and the Orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in this regard.

He shared with the members that some inimical persons tried to project that induction of Government officials in PCA is wrong and in this regard, even the Hon'ble Supreme Court has been



misquoted in a recent writ petition, whereby it has been alleged that induction of Ministers and Civil Servants in the State Association has been deprecated by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the case titled Board of Control for Cricket vs. Cricket Association of Bihar and Others. He informed the House that induction of Government officials/Public Servants in PCA as life members is as per the Rules and Regulations and does not amount to violation of the directions rendered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the aforesaid judgment. The bar/prohibition is that Government Officials/Public Servants cannot be the office bearers, which is not the case here.

Sh. Viswajeet Khanna informed the members that these all are renowned person in their fields and are cricket lovers who will assist PCA to grow and in promoting & developing the game of cricket in the State. He pointed out that recommendation/report of Justice Lodha Committee as accepted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court has been duly complied with and in future also, PCA is obliged to function strictly as per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Sh. M.P. Pandove shared with the members that during the last Annual General Body Meeting, responsibility was given to the Committee to recommend the names for grant of Life Membership. He further informed that the Committee has met many times, deliberated on various issues including how to grow the Association, contribution of old members who helped the Punjab Teams during its initial stages when there was not much money to even send the teams for participation in the National Tournaments. He expressed his thanks to the President for accepting the recommendations of two members of the Committee.

The President then requested members for their views.

Sh. Raman Ghai informed the members that the Cricket is being promoted and conducted at the grass root level through District Cricket Associations and the House may also consider to enroll at least five members from each District Cricket Association as Life Member. Sh. Sheikhar Shukla seconded the proposal.

Mr. Vishwajeet Khanna explained to the House the fixation of criteria of the new members and thereafter, the Members of the Apex Council present (12 numbers) and General House being the supreme body In-charge of all affairs of PCA, after detailed discussions, unanimously approved the criteria for life membership to whom Life Membership has given as per list enclosed.

(Annexure – 'M')

- b) Sh. G.S. Walia, with the permission of the Chair, requested to constitute a committee comprising of Sh. Rajinder Gupta, President PCA, Sh. M.P. Pandove, Sh. D.P. Reddy, Sh. Viswajeet Khanna and Sh. R.S. Sachdeva to work out, resolve and settle all complaints or legal matters pending in courts or before any other forum, concerning PCA, or its associate members.

He further proposed that, this committee will also devise a mechanism to deal with any or all complaints or legal issues which may arise in the future which shall be referred by PCA to above said committee.

The House after detailed discussions unanimously resolved to constitute the Dispute Redressal Committee comprising of Sh. Rajinder Gupta, President PCA, Sh. M.P. Pandove, Sh. D.P. Reddy, Sh. Viswajeet Khanna and Sh. R.S. Sachdeva. The House further resolved that the committee is authorized to:-

- i) Examine the complaint and call any person or records relevant to the matter involved and if the complaint is *prima-facie* found to be without substance, it may dispose it off without any further action.



- ii) Identify the Core issues referred in the complaint requiring further examination of the committee.
- iii) If necessary, call all parties and try to get the matter resolved between them amicably.
- iv) If the matter is not resolved between the parties, the committee would refer the matter to the Apex Council for further action along with its findings.

All decisions taken by the committee would be sent to the CEO for placing it on the records of PCA and for bringing the summary of its work done for the information of the AGM.

In General, also for legal matters for or against PCA in all Tribunals/Forums/Hon'ble Courts/Statutory Authorities, keeping in view the fact that Honorary Secretary himself is a Senior Advocate practicing in the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and in the Hon'ble Supreme Court thus, he should not be put in a position where he can have possible 'Conflict of Interest'. Therefore, the General House, while considering the scope of its powers under Rule 15 (1) (c) and Rule 32 (22) unanimously resolved that the Honorary Secretary would engage lawyers to defend PCA in consultation with the President and the CEO and all 03 of them would jointly approve the panel of Lawyers or Lawyer for legal matters. The General House further authorised the CEO to sign and execute all legal documents to defend the cause of PCA. In case any of the office bearers has been impleaded by name in any legal proceedings, he or she shall have first right to engage Lawyer at his own personal expense otherwise, the above process shall be followed.

Sh. D.N. Jauhar informed that he supports the Resolution and further proposed that Committee may consider the complaint only when it is accompanied by the Sworn Affidavit, duly attested/notarized and photograph.

The President remarked that the Dispute Resolution Committee will proceed as per law and keeping in view the Rules and Regulations of the Association.

- c) The President informed the members that the Apex Council in its last Meeting had discussed regarding some members having 'Conflict of Interest' and requested the House to guide in this regard. Sh. Rakesh Rathour, Vice President remarked that we respect them and the Apex Council is an elected Body.

The President remarked that we may invite them as Special Invitees.

- d) The President informed the House that in the last AGM, the Ludhiana Cricket Club had been disaffiliated. He further shared that it has transpired at this stage that Sh. Sanjeev Arora is "Sworn Brother" (Dharm-Bhai) of his close relative and thus, have Conflict of Interest and he recused himself from taking any decision in this regard.

Sh. D.P. Reddy proposed that Sh. Sanjeev Arora may continue as member of the Apex Council. Sh. Viswajeet Khanna seconded the proposal. The House after detailed discussions unanimously resolved that Sh. Sanjeev Arora will continue as member of the Apex Council.

- e) The House then requested Sh. Sanjeev Arora to be on the Stadium Construction Committee, also as he has vast knowledge and experience. Sh. Sanjeev Arora accepted the proposal.

- f) Sh. M.P. Pandove shared with members that in last Annual General Body, we have constituted Cricket Advisory Committee (CAC) with 3 Members. However, the CAC may be enriched so as to cover all cricketing aspects. He further proposed to enlarge that CAC by having 5 Members. The President thanked Mr. M.P. Pandove and offered his services to the CAC, provided Rules Permit. Sh. M.P. Pandove informed that the President can attend any meeting. However, CAC being Cricket Committee the



President may not be the member of the Committee. The House after detailed discussions authorised the President, if necessary.

Sh. Bhupinder Singh Senior, Chairman, CAC shared with members that CAC members are honorary members and in case any member has any objection on any of the decision of the CAC, the same may be informed in writing.

The President shared with members that we appreciate the proposal of Sh. M.P. Pandove, Senior Member and assure the House that our main target is to win the Ranji Trophy and we all will proceed to achieve our collective dream.

- g)** The President informed that in addition to PCA getting the Sponsorship, even some of the Districts have also got sponsors. He specially mentioned Kapurthala, Bathinda, Sangrur, Barnala and Mansa, who have done very well during the last year. The members appreciated the efforts made by the President to make Districts self-sufficient.

After these detailed discussions on the Action Taken Report (ATR) and the decision taken there upon, the Minutes of the Annual General Body meeting dated 28th March, 2021 were approved unanimously, and Actions Taken on the decisions of the last Annual General Body meeting along with above discussions were noted and approved by the House.

The President then informed the members that the Agenda & Agenda Notes were duly circulated to the Members and we may treat them as read. He further informed that the next major item is approved and adoption of Accounts. He shared with the House that Auditors as well as accounts team is available to assist the members for any query.

The members discussed and unanimously approved the decisions as proposed in the notes Item wise, and reproduced below: -

Item No.3 To discuss and adopt the Report of the Secretary (Annual Report), as recommended by the Apex Council for the year 2020-21. (Annexure-'C')

The Report of the Secretary (Annual Report of the Association) was duly approved and adopted unanimously.

Item No.4: To discuss and adopt the Treasurer's Report, as recommended by the Apex Council and the audited accounts for the year 2020-21. (Annexure-'D' & 'D'-1)

The Treasurer's Report as recommended by the Apex Council and Audited Accounts for the year 2020-21 were duly approved and adopted unanimously.

The House also approved the resolution for accumulation under section 11 (2) of the Income Tax Act as detailed below: -

It is for the kind information of the members that, in terms of Section 11 (1) of the Income Tax Act, 85% of the total income i.e. Rs.29,70,45,561/- was to be spent on the objects of the association during the F.Y 2020-21. An amount of Rs.10,45,47,094/- was spent on the objects of the association during the F.Y 2020-21. Accordingly, the amount of Rs.19,24,98,468/- is to be accumulated in terms of Section 11 (2) of the Income tax Act, which is to be spent on the objectives of the association in the next five years.

Further, the PCA has already utilized the unspent amount of Rs.2,56,94,174/- and Rs.11,83,87,788/- against the accumulated reserves of A.Y 2015-16(F.Y 2014-15) and A.Y 2016- 17 (F.Y 2015-16) respectively on capital expenditure on new Cricket Stadium at Mullanpur. The detailed sheet containing "Computation of Amount applied for Charitable purposes" is attached herewith.



The Members after detailed discussions unanimously approved the following resolutions, as per Income Tax Rules:-

“That as per Income Tax act, PCA needs to expend 85% of the revenue on the objectives of the association. However, for the year 2020-21, Rs.19,24,98,468/- is less on the spending side and has to be accumulated u/s 11(2) of the Income Tax Act and will be spent on the objectives of the association in the next five years”.

“That an amount of Rs.2,56,94,174/- and Rs.11,83,87,788/- has been utilized against unspent accumulated reserves of A.Y 2015-16 (F.Y 2014-15) and A.Y 2016-17 (F.Y 2015-16) respectively”.

Item No.5: To consider and adopt the Annual Budget of the Association for the year 2021-22 as recommended by the Apex Council. (Annexure-'E')

The Annual Budget of the Association for the year 2021-22, as recommended by the Apex Council was duly approved and adopted by the General Body.

Item No.6: To discuss and approve the appointment of Auditors for the year 2021-22 and fix their remuneration, as recommended by the Apex Council. (Annexure-'F')

The Apex Council in its Meeting dated 4th October, 2021 has recommended to appoint M/s R. Dewan & Company as Statutory Auditors for the next year 2021-22 on the same remuneration i.e. Rs.10.00 Lacs plus GST per annum, who had done a commendable job in the last year 2020-21.

The President abstained from the discussion on the point and shared with the Members that one of the partners of M/s R. Dewan & Company is Chairman, Trident Limited.

The House unanimously approved the appointment of M/s R. Dewan & Company as Statutory Auditors for the year 2021-22 in the remuneration.

Item No.7: To discuss and appoint Ombudsman and Ethics Officer for the year 2021-22. (Annexure-'G')

As per the Memorandum and Rules & Regulations of the Punjab Cricket Association, the General Body has to appoint Ombudsman & Ethics Officer. The General Body in its Meeting dated 28th March, 2021 had appointed Hon'ble Justice H.S. Bhalla as Ombudsman-cum-Ethics Officer. The Apex Council has recommended the name of Hon'ble Justice H.S. Bhalla as Ombudsman-cum-Ethics Officer for the year 2021-22 to the General Body for appointment.

The Members unanimously approved the recommendations of the Apex Council to appoint Hon'ble Justice H.S. Bhalla as Ombudsman-cum-Ethics Officer for the year 2021-22 on existing terms of reference.

Item No.8: To discuss and appoint the Cricket Committees and Standing Committees as mentioned in Rules 34 and 33 and guidelines as per the Memorandum and Rules & Regulations of the Association and recommendations of the Apex Council. (Annexure-'H' & 'H'-1)

The House discussed the Minutes/ Reports of the Apex Council, CEO and the Committees, as circulated and satisfactorily took note of the same.

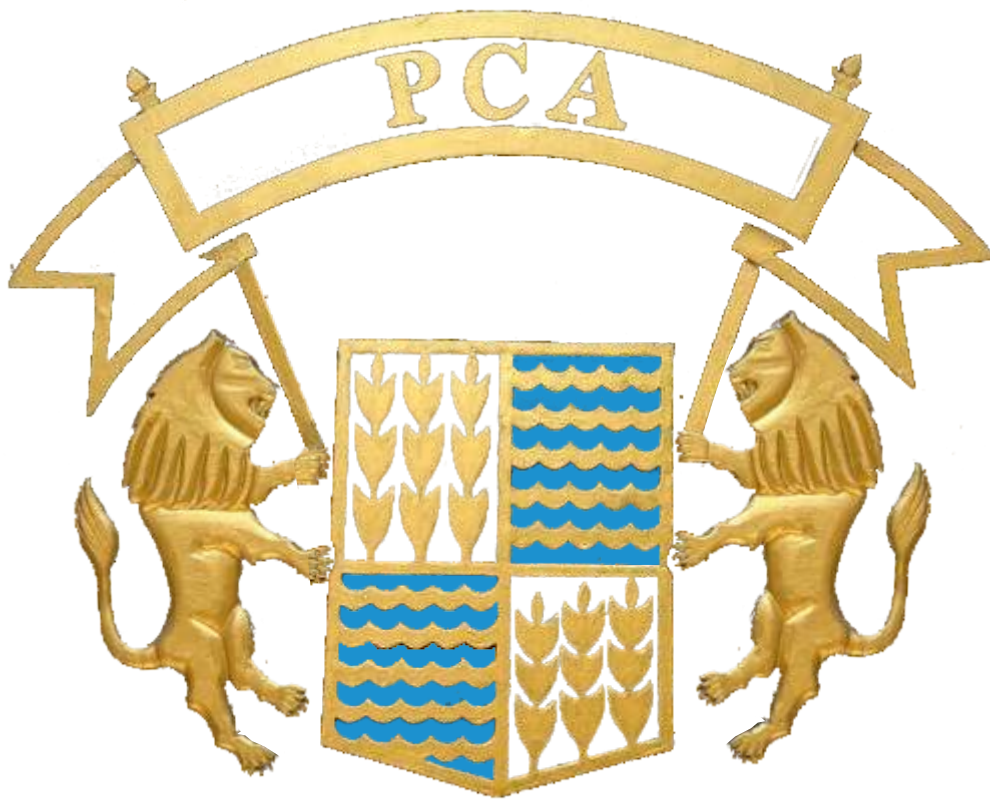

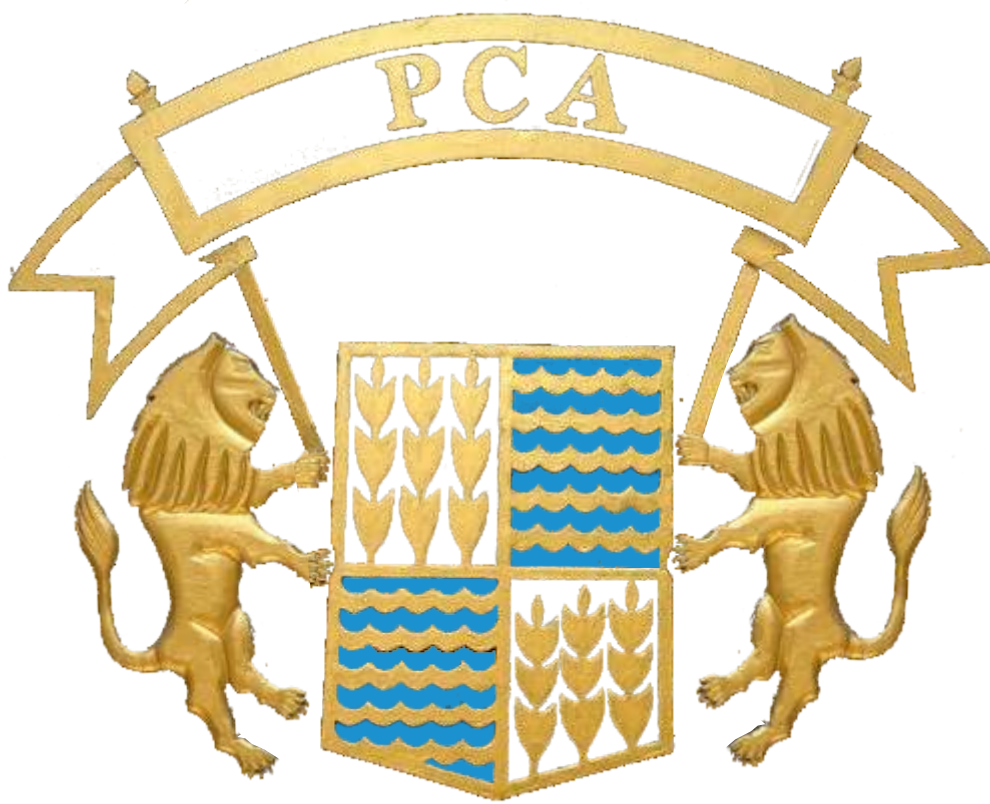

REPORT OF THE HONORARY SECRETARY, PCA

Dear Members,

I am pleased to present the 74th Annual Report of the Association for the year 2021-22.

The year under report was a mixed bag for the Association with respect to performance of Punjab Teams. However, PCA performed creditably on account of conduct the tournaments, camps and State tournaments. The BCCI had allotted India vs. Sri Lanka Cricket Test match which was organized from 4th to 8th March, 2022 at I.S. Bindra Stadium, PCA, Mohali. In view of cautious approach because of pandemic and guidelines of the BCCI, the PCA had setup a Bio-Bubble for both the Teams at Ground as well as in Hotel.

The International match, being 100th Test Match of Virat Kohli, the BCCI Office Bearers visited PCA on the first day of the Test Match and felicitated Mr. Virat Kohli. The PCA had also presented the Silver plaque and a Gold coin commemorating the event.

The event was also graced by the His Excellency Governor of Punjab, Hon'ble Chief Justice of Punjab & Haryana High Court and other dignitaries.

The Association had engaged professional Coaches & Support staff for the Senior & Junior Teams. The Punjab Senior team could not qualify for knockout stage matches in Inter State One day & T-20 tournament. However, the Punjab Senior Team qualified for knockout in Ranji Trophy and will be resuming their journey in the month of June as per schedule circulated by BCCI.

The Punjab Under 25 years team qualified for knockout stage of matches in Col. C.K. Nayudu Trophy but lost in quarter final match. The Team had made better performance in Inter State Under 25 years One day limited overs matches and reached final of the tournament, where they lost to Gujarat and came Second Best.

The Punjab under-19 teams could not qualify either in multiday or one day tournaments. The Inter State Under-16 years tournament was not staged by BCCI, as the young players were not vaccinated.

The Punjab women team performed creditably and Senior women team qualified for knockout. The Punjab Senior Women team beaten Maharashtra in quarter finals. However, the semi-final was washed out and Punjab Senior Women team could not proceed further on lower net run rate.

The Punjab Under-19 Women team also qualified for knockout after beating teams like Karnataka, Himachal Pradesh & Odisha. The team lost to Uttarakhand in the quarter final.

I would also like to inform the members that PCA had organized three Inter State Tournaments on behalf of BCCI. All Teams and Match officials had praised the arrangements made by PCA including setting up of Bio-bubble and regular RT-PCR tests.

I feel privileged to share with members that two PCA stalwarts i.e. S. Harbhajan Singh, Former Indian Test player & Sh. Sanjeev Arora, Life Member got elected unopposed as Hon'ble Members of Parliament (Rajya Sabha).

I would like to convey my thanks to all my colleagues, Members of Apex Council, District Cricket Associations and PCA Officials for active assistance in smooth functioning of the Association.

INTERNATIONAL ENGAGEMENTS

INDIA VS SRI LANKA TEST MATCH (04-08 MARCH, 2022)

The Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) had allotted India Vs Sri Lanka Cricket Test Match to Punjab Cricket Association. The International match was played from 4th March to 8th March, 2022 at IS Bindra Stadium, PCA, Mohali.

The Apex Council had constituted a committee to upgrade and renovate the Stadium. Sh. Sanjeev Arora, Life Member, PCA deputed a Team of Engineers, Architect and other Professionals to assist PCA to get the renovation and upgradation works executed in a time bound manner on his own cost.

The Punjab Cricket Association (PCA) started preparations in the month of February, 2022 and completed upgradation & renovation of cricketing facilities, players dressing rooms, players gallery, long room and painting & polishing of the PCA Stadium Mohali before this marquee event.

The BCCI permitted 50% spectators for the event and accordingly, the PCA had made arrangements for printing and selling of the Tickets and roped in Paytm for this purpose, who had vast experience in this regard with various State Associations.

Keeping in view the Covid-19 restrictions issued by the BCCI, the bio-bubble was created from 20th February, 2022 and regular RT PCR Tests were conducted for grounds men and allied work force deputed in the bio-bubble.

The Fortis Hospital was engaged to provide medical facilities including RTPCR Tests, Services of Doctor in bio-bubble along with Team India, Team of Doctors along with Ambulance for players at practice and Test Match. The CMO deputed medical Teams in the Stadium to cater to spectators & for any medical emergency.

The PCA roped in Mr. Joe Baath, who has vast experience in IPL, for making public announcements and to engage spectators for active participation which made the atmosphere more lively. Mr. Joe Baath truly galvanized the spectators and shared important milestones with the spectators from time to time in addition to introducing various dignitaries.

The event was graced by His Excellency, Governor of Punjab, Shri Banwarilal Purohit and Hon'ble Chief Justice of Punjab and Haryana High Court along with other dignitaries during the Test Match.





The Test Match also happened to be the 100th Test Match of Virat Kohli was a must watch event for the Cricket Lovers. The PCA made befitting arrangements to felicitate Virat Kohli, Former Captain, Team India at opening ceremony of the Test Match. Mr. Sourav

Ganguly President, Mr. Rajeev Shukla Vice President, Mr. Jay Shah Honorary Secretary and Mr. Arun Dhumal Honorary Treasurer, BCCI along with PCA Office Bearers graced the felicitation ceremony.





The Team India, being in the bio-bubble, Mr. Rahul Dravid, Coach of the Team India presented the commemorative Test Cap representing 100th Test Match to Mr. Virat Kohli on behalf of BCCI. He then felicitated Virat by presenting a Silver Plate and

specially designed 100 Grams gold coin celebrating the 100th Test Match on behalf of PCA. During the ceremony, Virat Kohli was accompanied by his wife Anushka Sharma.







It being the First Test Match, after T-20 Series between both Nations, the Test Specialist Players of India and Sri Lanka had started visiting Chandigarh and entered into quarantine from 20th February, 2022. The PCA had made detailed arrangements and provided best facilities during practice sessions

within sanctity of the bio-bubble. The Bio-bubble was created for the Teams, support Staff and BCCI Match support Team at PCA Stadium, Mohali. The Association has also got complete support from District and Police Administration for making the event successful.





The PCA ground proved lucky for Skipper Rohit Sharma, who won the toss and elected to bat. Mayank Aggarwal and Rohit Sharma both the openers provided a good start with partnership of 52 runs. Rohit Sharma looked in good form but could not convert the start in big score and got out after scoring 29 runs of 28 balls. After the fall of first wicket of Rohit Sharma, Hanuma Vihari and Mayank Aggarwal took the score-board to 80 runs. After the fall of wicket of Mayank Aggarwal, Virat Kohli joined Vihari on the crease. There were cheers and loud applause for Virat from the spectators.

However, Virat got out at 45 runs. After the fall of 3rd wicket, Rishabh Pant came on the crease and true to his batting style started belting boundaries to all corners. He was ably supported by Ravindra Jadeja. Rishabh Pant scored 96 with the help of 4 sixes and 9 boundaries. India was 357 of 6 on the first day of the match. Ravindra Jadeja carried on with his form from the previous day and scored an unbeaten 175 runs. Ravichandran Ashwin ably supported Ravindra Jadeja and scored 61 runs.

India declared their innings at 574 for 8 and put Sri Lanka to bat.





The Team Sri Lanka started cautiously but the spin duo Ashwin and Jadeja spun web around Sri Lankan batsmen. Sri Lanka was 108 for 4 after 43 overs at the end of second day of the match.

On 3rd day of the match, Ravindra Jadeja was unplayable. Charith Asalanka was the only batsman from Sri Lanka who scored 50 runs in 108 balls with 9 boundaries and was not out at 61 when the Sri Lankan innings folded at 174 runs in 65 overs.

Ravindra Jadeja, after receiving the Player of Match Award had all the praise for PCA and commented that the PCA Mohali is his lucky ground, where he has scored 327 runs at an average of 81.75 and claimed 27 wickets at 14.66 in 4 Test Matches.

India won the Test Match convincingly by an inning and 222 runs in 3 days.



India decided to enforce the follow on and second innings of the Sri Lanka was even shorter, lasting only 60 overs. Niroschan Dickwella with unbeaten 51 runs was the top scorer. Jadeja and Ashwin took 4 wickets each in the 2nd innings. **Ravindra Jadeja** with 9 wickets haul and 175 not out in the match was declared **Player of the Match**.

Since the next match was being played at Bangalore, both the teams decided to have their practice sessions on 8th March, 2022 at PCA Mohali. Accordingly, the arrangements were made by PCA. The India Vs Sri Lanka First Test Match was a great success both administratively and financially. The PCA Team worked tirelessly to make this prestigious event memorable.





INTER STATE TOURNAMENTS FOR MEN 2021-2022

INTER STATE SENIOR (MULTI DAYS) TOURNAMENT FOR RANJI TROPHY

Punjab played their 1st match of Ranji Trophy against Himachal Pradesh at Arun Jaitley Stadium, New Delhi. Punjab won the toss and elected to field first. Batting first Himachal scored 388 for in 96 overs. Ankit 88 inclusive off 8 boundaries, Raghav Dhawan 73 with 10 boundaries and 1 six and Akash Vashisht 87 with 12 boundaries and 2 six were highest run getters for Himachal. Baltej Singh 5 for 61 was the main wicket taker for Punjab. Punjab in reply scored 526 in 116.2 overs and took 1st innings lead of 172 runs. Prabhsimran Singh 123 inclusive of 21 boundaries and 1 six, Abhishek Sharma 98 with 9 boundaries and 5 sixes and Mandeep Singh inclusive of 6 boundaries were the main contributors for Punjab in their 1st innings batting. Arpit Guleria 4 for 111 was the highest wicket taker for Himachal in their 1st innings. Himachal in 2nd innings scored 402 for 8 in 115.4 overs before the match ended in a draw. Akash Vashisht 140 with 15 boundaries and PM Thakur 103 off inclusive 13 boundaries were the top run getters for Himachal in their 2nd innings batting. Mayank Markande 3 for 103 and Arshdeep Singh 2 for 78 were the main wicket takers for Punjab. The match was drawn and Punjab got 3 points on the basis of first innings lead taken while Himachal got 1.

Punjab played their 2nd match against Haryana at Arun Jaitley Stadium from 24th -27 Feb 2022. Haryana won the toss and elected to field first. Punjab scored 444 all out in 111 overs. Mandeep Singh unbeaten 159 inclusive of 16 boundaries and 2 sixes and Anmol Malhotra 100 with 14 boundaries and 2 sixes were the highest run getters for Punjab in their first innings batting. Aman Kumar 4 for 88 and Ajit Chahal 3 for 74 were the main wicket takers for Haryana. Haryana in reply were bundled out for 282 in 88.5 overs. Himanshu Rana 149 with 19 boundaries and Yeshu Sharma 74 inclusive off 7 boundaries and 1 six were the main run getters for Haryana. Baltej Singh 4 for 57, Siddharth Kaul 3 for 63 and Arshdeep Singh 3 for 54 were the successful wicket takers for Punjab. Following on Haryana were again bundled out for 203 in 59.5 overs. Nishant Sindhu 57 with 7 boundaries was the highest run getter for Haryana. Baltej Singh 3 for 17, Abhishek 3 for 15 and Siddharth Kaul 2 for 75 were the highest wicket takers for Punjab. Punjab got the target of 41 in 8.5 overs without loss of any wicket. Punjab registered their first outright win for this season for Ranji Trophy and got 7 points while Haryana got 0.





Punjab played their last league match against Tripura at Arun Jaitley Stadium, Delhi. Punjab won the toss and elected to field first. Tripura batting first and scored 127 in 54.4 overs. Pawan KB 59 with 10 boundaries was the main run getter for Tripura. Baltej Singh 5 for 33, Siddharth Kaul 2 for 50 and Vinay Choudhary 2 for 22 were the main wicket takers for Punjab. Punjab in reply were bundled out for 120 in 37.4 overs. Anmol Malhotra 30 with 4 boundaries and Anmolpreet Singh 29 with 4 boundaries and 1 six were the highest run getters for Punjab. Tripura got 7 runs first innings lead. MB Murra Singh 6 for 48 and AB Sarkar 3 for 47 were the main wicket takers for

Tripura. Tripura in their 2nd innings were bundled out for 232 in 65.5 overs. MB Murra Singh 85 with 10 boundaries and 2 sixes and SS Ghosh 55 with 6 boundaries and 2 sixes for Tripura. Arshdeep Singh 5 for 33, Abhishek Sharma 3 for 23 and Siddharth Kaul 2 for 57 were the main contributor with the ball for Punjab. Tripura set a target of 240 runs for Punjab. Punjab got the target in 66 overs and scored 240 for 4. Mandeep Singh unbeaten 97 inclusive of 13 boundaries, Anmolpreet Singh 64 with 9 boundaries and Ramandeep Singh 43 with 7 boundaries were the main contributor with the bat in Punjab win. Punjab got 6 points while Tripura got 0.



Punjab qualified for the knock out stage of Ranji Trophy. However, due to IPL the BCCI decided to hold the Knock out stage matches in the month of June,

2022. The Punjab Team will be playing their Quarter Final match against Madhya Pradesh. The exact dates and venue will be informed by BCCI.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS 2021-22

Due to Covid 19 and in spite of many hindrances, during the Cricket Season 2021-2022, Punjab Cricket Association had organised Inter District tournaments for various age groups as well as Seniors. The One Day, T-20 as well as Multi-days tournament were organised at different District Headquarters as well as at Mohali and Mullanpur Grounds. The PCA had also organised Winners vs Rest of Punjab Tournament matches on the lines of Irani Trophy. PCA had organised 500 match days cricket for men and women. All the matches were officiated by PCA Panel Umpires, Match Referees, Scorers and performance of the players was watched by the Members of

Punjab State Junior Cricket Committee and Senior Selection Committee. SG Test Red Cricket balls were used in the days matches while SG Test White cricket balls with coloured clothings were used in the tournaments.

The 20 Districts teams participated in each tournament and Teams were divided into four groups i.e. 5 teams each group. Top team from each group played the semi-finals. The league matches were of two days duration, while the Semi-final and finals were of four days. The detailed tournament wise report is as under:

PUNJAB STATE INTER DISTRICT U-16 YEARS TOURNAMENT

The Punjab State Inter District Under 16 years tournament was organised from 5th August to 28th August, 2021 at various District Head Quarters. Patiala top team of Group – A with 23 points clashed with Jalandhar top team of Group C with 20 points and Ludhiana top team of Group B with 16 points clashed with Amritsar top team of Group D with 21 points in the Semi-finals, which were played from 20th August to 23rd August, 2021 at Patiala and Ludhiana respectively. After defeating Ludhiana, Amritsar reached the final and clashed with Patiala who defeated Jalandhar with an innings and 120 runs in the semi-finals.

Patiala top team of Group – A with 16 points clashed with Hoshiarpur top team with 18 points of Group C and Mohali 2nd best team with 14 points of Group B clashed with Amritsar top team with 24 points of Group D in the Semi finals, which were played from 17th July, 2021 to 20th July, 2021 at Patiala and Amritsar respectively. Ludhiana no. 1 team of Group – B with 18 points got Debarred from the tournament due to protest for fielding of overage player by Ludhiana lodged by Moga DCA. After defeating Hoshiarpur, Patiala reached the final and clashed with Mohali who defeated Amritsar in the semi finals.

In the finals, Mohali won the toss and decided to bat first. Mohali scored 390 all out in 152.1 overs. Singh Ricky, BCCI Level-2 were the faculty members. 64 Coaches had participated in the seminar and 38 coaches who have no formal certification appeared in the practical examination. 15 coaches cleared the examination with Grade- A, while 23 coaches were passed with Grade – B.

Punjab Cricket Association had organised Curator's Seminar on 17-18 December, 2021 at I.S. Bindra Cricket Association Mohali. The curators from different districts participated in the Seminar. Mr. Rakesh Kumar, BCCI qualified Curator shared the knowledge about identification of quality of Pitch

Soil, its selection and effects on pitch behaviour, rolling of grass, practical- pitch preparation and playing conditions while Mr. Daljit Singh shared about Pitch preparation and Pitch construction and Mr. G.S. Saini briefed about Equipment – theory and practical. The C.E.O. PCA had concluded the Seminar.

Report & Recommendations of the Senior Selection Committee

This year the senior team season starts with Syed Mustaq Ali Trophy T-20 matches. The selection committee selected the squad of 20 players out of 20 players 6 youngsters were selected in the squad. The two boys from so called minor districts were also selected in the squad. The team played good cricket but could not qualify for the knockout stage. In the Vijay Hazare Trophy 50 over matches, two young medium pacers were selected in the squad and made debut and were impressive. The last match of the league stage was tie and the team again could not qualify for knockout. The selection committee before selecting the squad for Ranji Trophy league matches take the feedback from the head coach on each player and their performances were analyzed. The areas where team lack, the areas to improve and reasons for not qualifying for knockout in the above mentioned white ball tournaments were discussed. Accordingly the committee decided to groom and make young captain for the Ranji Trophy matches this year. The squad under new captain was selected, 6 youngsters were selected in the squad. The team under new captain won all the matches convincingly against Haryana, HP and Tripura and top the table with 16 points from 3 matches. This top performance by the Punjab team results in to qualify for the knockout stage after 7 years. Further for the preparation of the Ranji Trophy knockout matches which are going to be held from 4th June 2022 the two camps were planned the, first camp was skill based and the other camp for playing three practice matches with the state team at different venues in Punjab. For the first camp which was held on 22/4/22 to 3/5/22 the committee selected 16 boys where in 5 youngsters from under - 19 state tournament performance were included this gave the youngsters exposure/ experience sharing with the senior players. It also gave opportunity for the head coach to watch the young upcoming talent of Punjab.

Further the committee identify the young /potential medium pacers and gave opportunity to attend the camp as net bowlers so that the coaches and trainer can have good look at them. This year chances were given to the youngsters by selecting them in the senior team in different formats of the game and few youngsters made debut in different formats and impress with their performances. As chairman selection committee overall the results were satisfying and I am sure with backing the right talent the results will defiantly come. I observed that the Punjab has lot of talent and coaches are working on the boys with modern technique which will defiantly show results in coming years. It is pertinent to mention here that being a local I often visited the camps and use to observe the senior team coaches, trainer and physio they all are working very hard with the boys. In the end on behalf of my selection committee members I thank all the PCA officials and special thanks to CAC for giving me and my co selectors opportunity to serve Punjab.

Report & Recommendations of the Junior Cricket Committee

Introduction

The Annual Report of the Punjab Junior selection committee for the season 2021-2022 is comprehensive and detailed. It also contains the overall view of the entire season of the Punjab Cricket Association.

U-19 one day

The One-day U-19 tournament was held during the end of July. Due to Monsoon, few matches were washed out. But we still managed to pick best 60 players for the camp. The selected players represented 4 teams for trail matches. Each team played atleast 4 matches. On the basis of their performance in trails matches, we selected 13 best performers to represent Rest of Punjab (ROP) to play against Mohali (BOP) at PCA Mohali. Rest of Punjab team won the match convincingly. After that we selected 20 best players to represent Punjab in U-19 Vinoo Mankad Trophy held at Hyderabad. Before the start of the main tournament Punjab team was supposed to play 4 practice matches against M.P. in Gwalior. Due to rain, only one inning each of two matches played was completed. This badly effect the preparation of Punjab team for the main event.

At the start of the tournament Punjab U-19 team lost first two matches and after that made a great come back with two back-to-back wins. In a must win game against Haryana, the match was not completed due to rain and three team finished the table on equal points including Punjab. On the basis of net run rate Punjab u-19 team could not qualify for the knock out stage.

U-19 days

After the appointment as Selector, we were able to watch only semi-finals and final of the u-19 days inter-district tournament and selected 38 probables for the preparatory camp on the basis of stats available on Cric Heros application. After the completion of the camp, 20 players were selected to represent Punjab State in U-19 Cooch Behar Trophy. The team played 2 practice matches in H.P. before heading to Pune for main event.

The Punjab team won 2 matches, lost 2 matches and one match goes without any result due to rain and finished 3rd in the Pool and could not qualify for the knock out stage.

U-25 one day

On the basis of performance in the inter district one day tournament, 39 probables were selected for the State camp. Out of which 20 players were shortlisted to represent Punjab State in Mens U-25 State A Trophy. The Punjab team did well in league matches by winning all the matches and stood top in the table and qualify for the knock out matches in Bangalore. The Punjab team became runner up in the tournament.

U-25 days

After the completion of the u-25 one day tournament, we selected 20 players for the U-25 Col CK Nayudu Trophy. The Punjab team topped the table by winning all the league matches and qualify for the knock stage. The team lost the quarter-final from M.P.

U-16 days

20 players were selected to represent Punjab in U-16 Inter State tournament to be held at Ahmedabad. The tournament could not start due to Covid 19.

The Committee had organized a series of webinars through Zoom sessions.
