An application has been received through email from the complainant Sh. Ashok Singla seeking permission to examine Sh. Anil Singla @ 'Bhola' by way of rebuttal. This application has been resisted by the Ld. Counsel from the Respondent submitting that the copy of the application has been received through an email at noon today itself.

I have gone through the contents of the application and it is nothing but a reproduction of the contents of an application earlier moved by Sh. Anil Singla @ 'Bhola' for impleading him as a party to the instant complaint. Application so moved by Sh. Anil Singla @ 'Bhola' for his impleadment was dismissed on merits after hearing the parties by the undersigned vide detailed order dated 30.07.2024.

Now, instant application has been moved for permission to examine to Sh. Anil Singla @ 'Bhola' in rebuttal on the similar lines as which were earlier narrated by him (Sh. Anil Singla @ 'Bhola') in his application for his impleadment.
